NOTICE OF RACE

CSC "Acclaim Insurance" Monsoon Regatta is held at the height of the NE Monsoon. All Racing and Cruising Keelboats, Catamarans, Sailing Dinghies and Sailability Dinghies are welcome.

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012), IRC 2009, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

3. CLASSES

The Regatta is open to self-righting Keelboats, Catamarans and Monohulls in the following classes:

IRC – Yachts with a valid IRC 2009 certificate.

One Design Class (minimum of 5 yachts)

PY Class – A CHN (Changi Handicap Number) will be allocated to each yacht by the Organising Authority.

Beach Catamaran – Texel Handicap numbers apply

Sailing Dinghies – Portsmouth Yardstick numbers apply

Sailability Dinghies

4. IRC REQUIREMENT

All participating yachts in the Racing Class must possess a valid IRC 2009 certificate.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Racing/PY Classes

There will be 3 races as specified in the Sailing Instructions. The races will start off Changi Sailing Club and the course will include channel markers in the vicinity of Changi, Pulau Ubin and Johore River.

6. SCORING

The Low Point System, provided in Appendix A of ISAF Racing Rules Sailing, will apply for all races.

Discards allowed:

When 3 or more races are sailed – The worst race score will be discarded

When less than 3 races are sailed – all races will count

7. ENTRY FEE

Eligible yachts shall apply for participation on the official entry form, which is available from Changi Sailing Club or at Website: www.csc.org.sg

Per Yacht & Skipper: S\$40.00

Each Crew Member: S\$15.00

(Price subjected to GST)

All entries shall be lodged on the attached entry form at the CSC office before 1700hrs on Wednesday 3rd March 2010 with the required entry fee. Late Entries will be accepted up to 1200hrs on Saturday 6th March 2010 accompanied by the additional late entry fee of \$20.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available by Friday, 5th March 2010, from the Regatta Secretariat at Changi Sailing Club.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 three yachts in each Class. The Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the Racing Class.

10. SAFETY

All yachts must comply with MPA Pleasure Craft Safety Requirements.

11. SOCIAL
